## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the policy is to ensure that all Company business activities can be kept at normal or near-normal performance following an incident that has the potential to disrupt or destroy the Company.

## **POLICY**

TCL will ensure effective Business Continuity System by following:

- Responsible Care (RC), It aims to encourage manufacturers and handlers of chemical substances to conduct their operations taking environmental protection and safety into consideration. Its scope covers the entire lifecycle of chemical substances from development to disposal. As an RC member we will follow the steps for continued safety procedures.
- Identifying Internal and external threats, liabilities and exposure, including risk concentrations that could cause the disruption to critical activities.
- Resource planning: What functions and people are essential and when. Allocating adequate resources & management energy.
- Aligning Business Continuity Process as per guideline from National Disaster Management Authority for astonishing exigencies.
- Complying with all relevant laws, regulation and standards applicable.
